

This 12-week university-level training not only qualifies graduates for the very best teaching jobs but can be taken for college credit or as a pathway to MA TESOL programs at Bridge partner universities.

The 120-Hour Master Certificate

This self-study online teacher certification course includes the 12-module core curriculum with interactive content, video tutorials, and tutor support, plus a grammar refresher course (Grammar Advisor) and two specialized endorsements: Teaching Business English and Teaching Young Learners. This course meets the hours requirement for most teaching jobs worldwide and online, making it a complete TEFL/TESOL package.

The 100-Hour Introductory Educator Plus Certificate

Covering all the TEFL/TESOL foundations, this course consists of the 12-module core curriculum, providing an examination of English language teaching foundations, such as effective lesson planning and the four language skills. Trainees receive tutor feedback in every module and complete a 40-hour English grammar refresher course.


The 60-Hour Introductory Educator Certificate

The core curriculum, this course consists of 12 modules covering English language teaching methodology and lesson planning. Tutor feedback is provided in every module.

The 40-Hour Basic Certificate

This 6-module introductory course is meant to be a first step into English language teaching. It includes some feedback from a personal tutor.

Teachers who start with a Foundational course (40, 60, or 100 hours) can upgrade anytime to the Professional-level 120-hour Master Certificate course, or add a Specialized Certificate or Micro-credential for training in a high-demand teaching area.



Bridge Specialized TEFL/TESOL Certificates

Targeted certification to develop expertise or qualify for jobs in high-demand teaching areas.

Specialized Certificates take general TEFL/TESOL training to the next level with additional training in high-demand areas of English language teaching, such as teaching English online. This additional training allows teachers to qualify for jobs in a preferred niche, to advance their careers with added credentials, or even to take part in a practicum to better prepare for the ESL classroom or online setting. These certifications can be added to the IDELT*Online*TM Diploma or any other Bridge course.




